Planning Applications (6/07/09)

Ouston Moor Farm Shed 2: John reported that the SBC website showed that the applicant had appealed although it was thought that no decision had been made. John would e-mail Stockton Borough Council for clarification.

The Stables, Kirkhill. The appeal has been refused.

Paragraph 5 of the inspectors report states that planning permission does not exist to use most of the plot of land as a domestic garden. The inspector also states that the decision of Stockton Council to allow a development to be built on that portion of the site within the limits of development has led to a 'long and tortured process'

It was agreed that we would write to Stockton Borough Council asking them to enforce the regulations with reference to

- use of agricultural land as domestic garden,
- the re-instatement of the boundary fence and
- the owner re-planting two hedges outside his boundary and on adopted highway land.
