SCP Dog show/fun day–progress on funding applications (8/05/17)

The application for £250 from Thirteen Group Housing Association to support the provision of children’s activities at the SCP fun day on 3rd June had been approved. The money had been transferred to the Parish Council account. The Clerk had been in touch with the Administrator for the SCP and agreed to pay for a children’s entertainer directly (£140) and transfer the remainder of the money (£110) to the SCP to support the provision of the bouncy castle.
